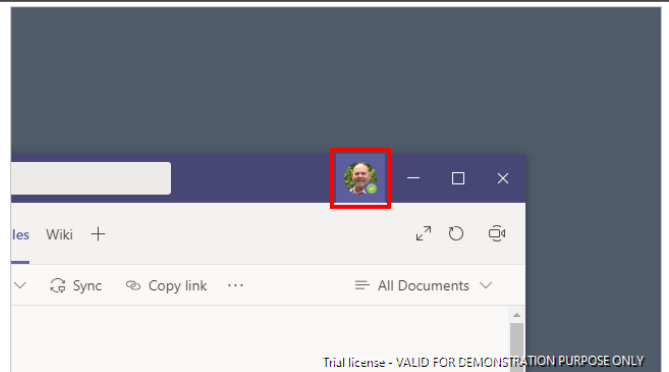

This procedure will show you how to: Enable Together Mode In Teams Desktop Application

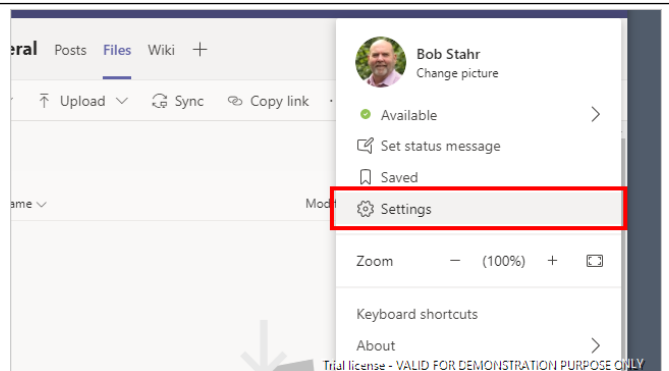
If Teams is not yet running on your desktop, Double click on your short cut to start Microsoft Teams.



Click on your picture or icon, the menu: **Profile, app settings, and more.**

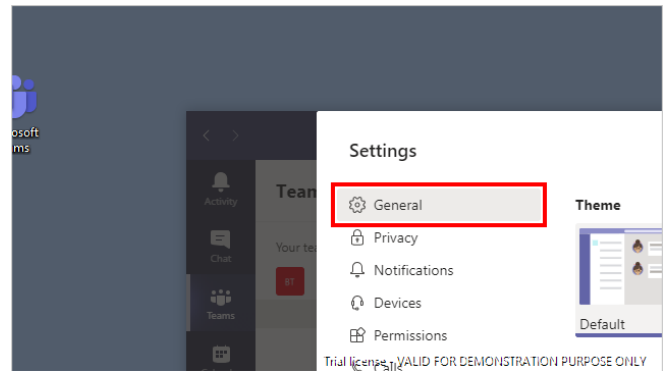


Click on the **Settings** item in the list.

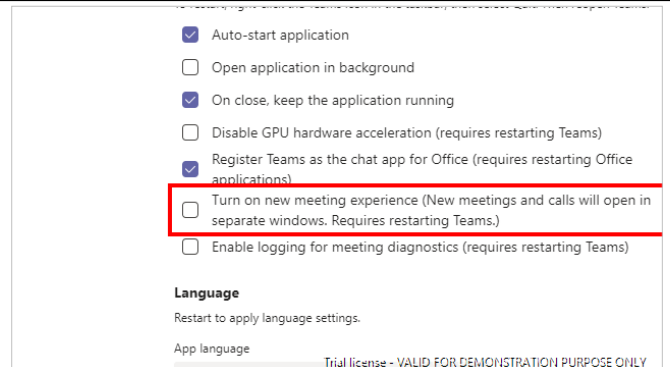

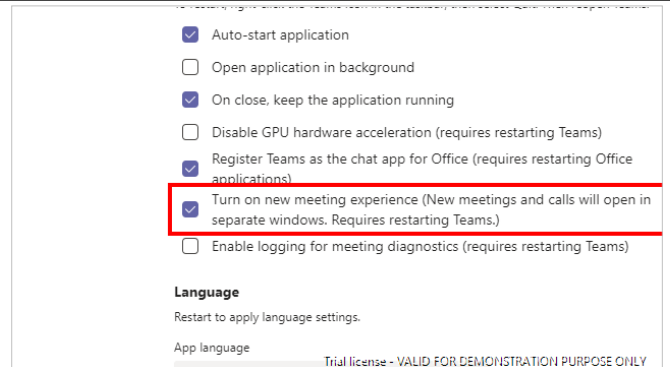
Click on the tab **General**.



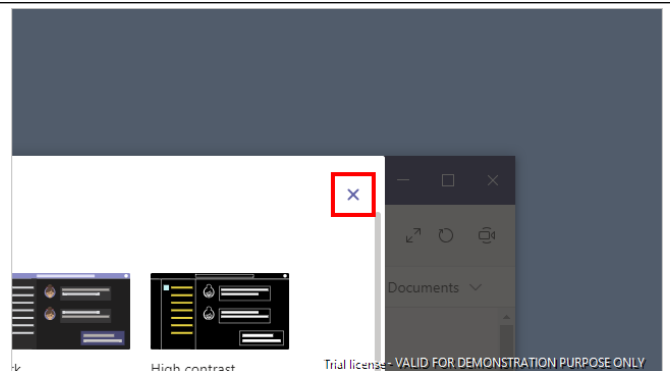
Click on the new feature in the list called: "Turn on new meeting experience (New meetings and calls will open in separate windows)"



The checkbox should now be checked, showing that the new feature is enabled.

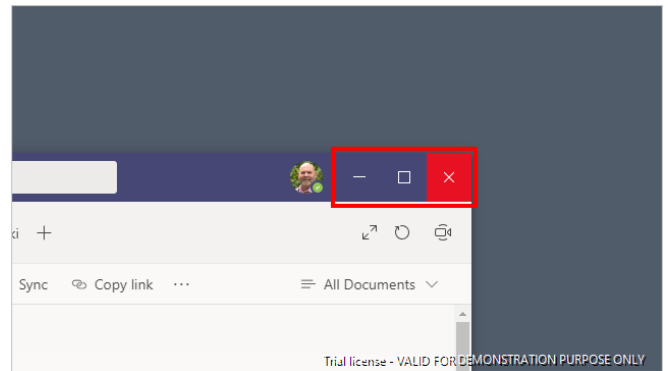


In the top right corner of the settings dialog box Click the X **Close Settings**

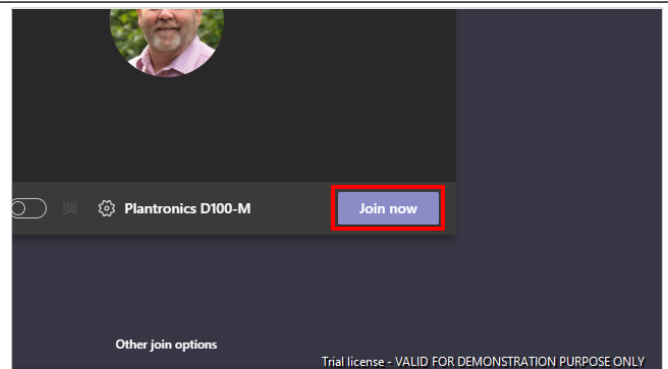
Click the X in the top right corner of the Microsoft Teams Application to exit.



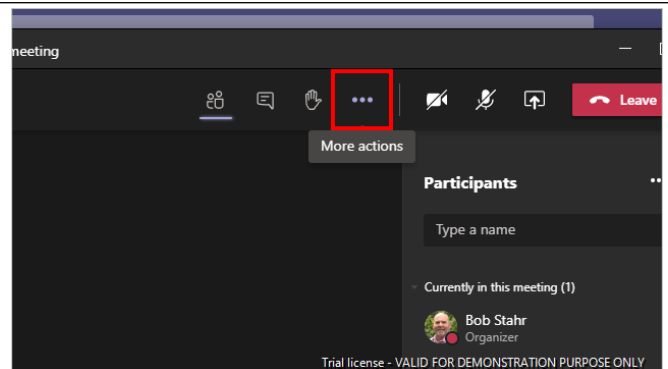
Double click on your short cut to restart **Microsoft Teams**.
